

The time was near! A few days after Jesus left, God the Holy Spirit came.












The visitors were amazed. "Whatever could this mean?" they asked. "They are full of new wine," others mocked.




But Peter said, "These are not drunk ...

Spirit," Peter Said.






Around 3000 people obeyed. They joined the disciples as worshipers of Jesus. As time passed, more and more people were added to the church God started the day the Holy Spirit









Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise and walk."








And he took him by the right hand and lifted him up. So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them walking, leaping, and praising God.























Peter had once been afraid to stand up for Jesus. But that was before the Holy Spirit came. Now nobody could frighten
